Allergy Awareness

We do have at least one student with a severe nut allergy enrolled at Osborne

All Saskatchewan Rivers Public Schools strive to maintain nut-alert environments for the safety and well-being of all students, staff and visitors. We ask that everyone please check food labels to ensure that nut products are not listed as an ingredient when shopping for school food items.

- ✓ Please send nut-free snacks and lunches to school.
- ✓ Cross-contamination is a common cause of anaphylactic reactions. Foods that have come in contact with nut products or contaminated utensils can also trigger allergic reactions.
- ✓ Check packaging labels for peanut/nut ingredients. If a product has “may contain trace amounts of peanuts or nuts” this is NOT safe to bring to school.

As students and staff visit other buildings, for a variety of events, all schools try to keep everyone safe. Our School Division hopes to establish and maintain, but cannot guarantee: schools, school environments and buses free of peanuts and nut products. Thank you for your cooperation with this very important safety matter.

Water Bottle Reminder

There are no water fountains at school, so please remember to send your child with a labelled refillable water bottle. We do have a filling station they are able to use to refill their water. Feel free to tell your child to leave their bottle at school during the week so it's one less thing they need to bring with them every morning.

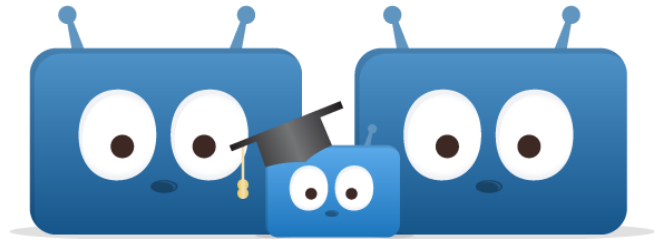
Cell Phone Policy Reminder

The Saskatchewan government instituted a cellphone/personal device ban on all classrooms in K-12 schools during instructional time. The rationale for this decision is rooted in providing an instructional climate free from the distractions caused by cellphones vibrating or ringing and disrupting student focus. This new provincial policy will not impose significant change for operations at Osborne Public School, as we have long had a no-cellphone/personal device policy during instructional time as well during school hours. We encourage parents to call the school office if they need to speak with their child(ren). As always, we will be having conversations with students at the beginning of this school year about the use of cellphone and personal devices at school. When a student is found using a cellphone or personal device, our school procedure is as follows:

(1st violation) Student is given a verbal reminder by staff member.

(2nd violation) Student is asked to hand over the phone and it is given to School Administration to be retrieved at the end of the day by the student, and parent is called.

(3rd violation) Student is asked to hand over the phone and it is given to School Administration; parent is called and will be asked to pick up the phone from the school at their convenience
